The **FM060-25-CM** is a single-axis servo drive and integration board assembly for a FE060-25-CM FlexPro[®] series servo drive with IMPACT[™] architecture. Connections to the controller, motor, power, and feedback are simplified through the standard connectors featured on the board.

The **FM060-25-CM** offers full tuning control of all servo loops and is designed to drive brushed and brushless servo motors, stepper motors, and AC induction motors. The drive accepts a variety of external command signals, or can use the builtin Motion Engine, an internal motion controller used with Sequencing and Indexing commands. Programmable digital and analog I/O are included to enhance interfacing with external controllers and devices.

The **FM060-25-CM** utilizes CANopen network communication and is configured via USB. All drive and motor parameters are stored in non-volatile memory.

IMPACT[™] (Integrated Motion Platform And Control Technology) combines exceptional processing capability and highcurrent components to create powerful, compact, feature-loaded servo solutions. IMPACT[™] is used in all FlexPro[®] drives and is available in custom products as well.



Status LED Functions

LED	Description
STAT	Indicates drive power bridge status. GREEN when DC bus power is applied and the drive is enabled. RED when the drive is in a fault state.
LOGIC PWR	Indicates that +5V logic power is available to the drive. GREEN when +5V logic power is available.

The CANopen Node ID and baud rate are set using DIP Switch SW1. Switch settings are given in the below table.

Safe Torque Off (STO) Inputs

The Safe Torque Off (STO) inputs are dedicated +5VDC sinking single-ended inputs. For applications not using STO functionality, disabling of the STO feature is required for proper drive operation. STO may be disabled by following the STO Disable wiring instructions as given in the hardware installation manual.

Mating Connector Kit

Mating connector housing and crimp contacts can be ordered as a kit using ADVANCED Motion Controls' part number KC-MC1XFM01. This includes mating connector housing and crimp style contacts for the Communication, I/O and Logic, and Feedback connectors. The recommended tool for crimping the contacts is Molex PN: 63819-1500 (not included with the kit).

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
